2. To place your request for flowers, pick up and complete a "Sanctuary Flowers" order form.
3. Turn in your completed form with payment to the church office.
4. Once we receive your request, you will be contacted to confirm your order. *As we receive and confirm new orders, the "calendar available date list" will be updated.*
