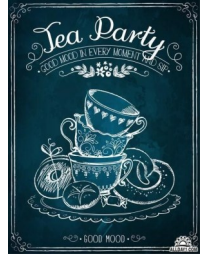

Rolling River Rampage June 18-22; 9am-12pm

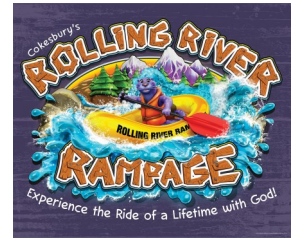
Registration is now OPEN!

HAVE YOU CONNECTED WITH MSPC VIA REALM? A little over 200 persons have not answered the invitation from MSPC to join our new online church program.

Being the church doesn't just happen at the church or during regular business hours. **Using Realm you can search the church directory for a member in order to obtain his/her address or phone number** *(if that individual has set his/her privacy setting to allow the congregation see this information)*. Using Realm you can search for that information at any time you need it or when it is convenient for you. If you have downloaded the Realm app to your smart phone (icon is labeled "Connect"), you have access whenever and wherever you may be.

It is also helpful for church staff when you can update your contact information when you have a change in address or phone number. Some families have discontinued their home or residential phone. If you no longer have a home phone, please check your record and delete the number if it is still listed.
