## PRAYERS FOR HEALING SUNDAY, JUNE 3; 7:00PM JESUS - GOD OF HEALING MIRACLES

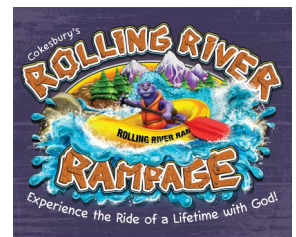
*"It is good to give thanks to the Lord, for His love endures forever." 1 Chronicles 16:34*

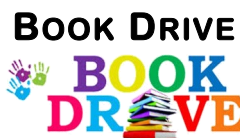
