donating a new or gently used children's book. Monetary donations will be accepted and used to purchase new books. You may place your book donations in the designated collection box in the narthex.



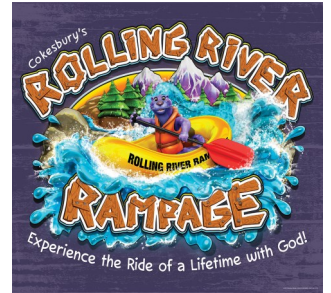
We are participating in the **baby bottle** fund raiser for Pregnancy Care of Cincinnati Life Forward. Pick up an empty
